SHROPSHIRE BOWLING LEAGUE

As part of competing or spectating within TWSBL fixtures and competitions you will at all times be expected to observe the TWSBL Code of Conduct.

On and off the bowling green, you will:

- Adhere to the laws of the game.
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour.
- Encourage fair play.
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment.
- Never engage in public criticism of league officials, match referees or opponents.
- Always win or lose with dignity and shake hands with my opponent at the beginning and end of every game.
- Only consume alcohol purchased at the venue of any league event.

You understand that if you do not follow the TWSBL code of conduct you may:

- Be required to apologise to the other player, team or club.
- Be required to explain my actions to the TWSBL.
- Be fined by the TWSBL.
- Be suspended from playing within the TWSBL and its competitions.
- Be banned from participating in all TWSBL activities.
- Force a team to incur a points deduction

Social Media

Social media, is increasingly playing a wider role within the non-playing aspect of Crown Green Bowling and is very important in promoting the TWSBL along with the social aspect of the game amongst the wider bowling community.

You understand that if You do not observe the TWSBL code of conduct whilst utilising social media you may:

- Be barred from using TWSBL related social media sites.
- Be suspended from playing within the TWSBL.
- Be banned from participating in all TWSBL activities.

In addition:

The SCGBA\BCGBA could impose a fine, suspension or ban to players, teams or clubs.

This Code of Conduct shall be endorsed by all clubs and managed by the TWSBL Management Committee.
